

# Adoption of Third-party English Proficiency Test for Entrance Examination for Master's Course, Graduate School of Engineering (2021 Academic Year)

From the entrance examination for the 2017 academic year (implemented in August 2016), the Master's Course of the Graduate School of Engineering, University of Miyazaki have adopted the third-party English proficiency tests, as outlined below.

The details will be outlined in the admission information to be announced in June 2020.

#### 1. Entrance Examination

From the entrance examination for the 2017 academic year (implemented in August 2016), the foreign language (English) writing test have been replaced by the third-party English proficiency tests mentioned below. Accordingly, the foreign language (English) writing test have not been implemented.

#### 2. Entrance Examinations Affected

Master's Course, Graduate School of Engineering, University of Miyazaki: Regular entrance examination, entrance examination for students with full-time jobs, entrance examination for international students<sup>1</sup>.

<sup>1</sup>Applicant may not need to submit the score sheet mentioned below if he/she is a national of a country which the faculty deems to be English-speaking.

## 3. Score Sheets Accepted

TOEIC®Listening&Reading test
TOEIC®Listening&Reading IP test/College TOEIC
TOEFL iBT® test

### 4. Submission of Score Sheets, Deadline

At the time of application, please submit the original copy of Official Score Certificate of the TOEIC, the original copy of Score Report of the TOEIC IP (College TOEIC), or the original copy of score report of the TOEFL.

As for the entrance examination for the 2021 academic year (scheduled to be implemented in August 2020), the score sheet of English test which is carried out after April 2017 is considered valid.

Note 1: TOEIC and other tests are carried out on the specific dates at the specific testing locations. Applicants are advised to take the test as soon as possible, taking into account the submission deadline. Test fees are at the expense of the applicant's own expense.

Note 2: The application without the original copy of the tests mentioned above is not acceptable.
