Pluto was once ① to be the ninth planet in our Solar System. It was first noticed in 1930 by an American astronomer\* in Arizona. Later, in 1978, it was calculated that Pluto was around 2,400 kilometers wide. Although this may seem relatively large, it is quite small compared to the other planets. Mercury, which was the smallest planet before the appearance of Pluto, is around twice that width.

Around 2000, scientists began to ② if Pluto was a real planet. This was because another large object was ③ in the same area of the Solar System. This large object, named “Eris,” was found by a team of astronomers at the California Institute of Technology\*. The astronomers learned that Eris ④ the same mixture of ice and rock as Pluto. Moreover, it was later realized that Eris is about 200 kilometers wider than Pluto and has 25% more mass.

After the announcement of the ⑤ of Eris and the other objects, the members of the International Astronomical Union (IAU)\* voted to ⑥ whether Pluto was a real planet or not. ⑦ the IAU, a real planet had to meet three conditions: (i) orbit the Sun, (ii) have enough mass to be a round shape, and (iii) be the only large object in its area of space. Since it did not meet the third condition, the IAU ⑧ that Pluto was not a regular planet, but a “dwarf planet.”
