Toshitaka Suzuki, a university professor, has been studying birds in Nagano Prefecture for nearly 20 years. (①) on his careful observations in the forests, he believes that some birds use gestures to communicate with each other. After (②) many years studying birds in the forests, Suzuki noticed that some female birds flap their wings to tell a male bird to go into the nest first. When the female did this wing flap, the male usually went inside quickly, in about 10 to 15 seconds. But when she did not flap, the male waited a few minutes. This (③) that birds may use simple body movements to send messages, like humans do.

This discovery is interesting because it used to be thought that only humans and some primates like monkeys used gestures to share meaning. The bird's wing flap seems like a message meaning "You go first." This is (④) from other animal actions, like a peacock showing its feathers or a cat raising its fur. (⑤), animals indicate some feeling, but do not send a clear, specific message to other animals. Suzuki thinks his finding can help people learn more about how animals use body language to communicate.

But some people do not (⑥) that this wing flap is really a gesture. They say the wing movement might just be a normal part of the bird's behavior or a sign of nervousness, not communication. (⑦), the gesture was only seen in some birds, not all of them. More studies (⑧) to know if other birds do this too. Still, Suzuki's research helps us think about how animals might talk to each other in ways we did not understand before.

- Kei: I don't want the largest screen, but I would like to have more memory.
- Mom: OK, then this one would be the best option for you. I'll buy it.
- Kei: Thanks Mom, you're the best!
