

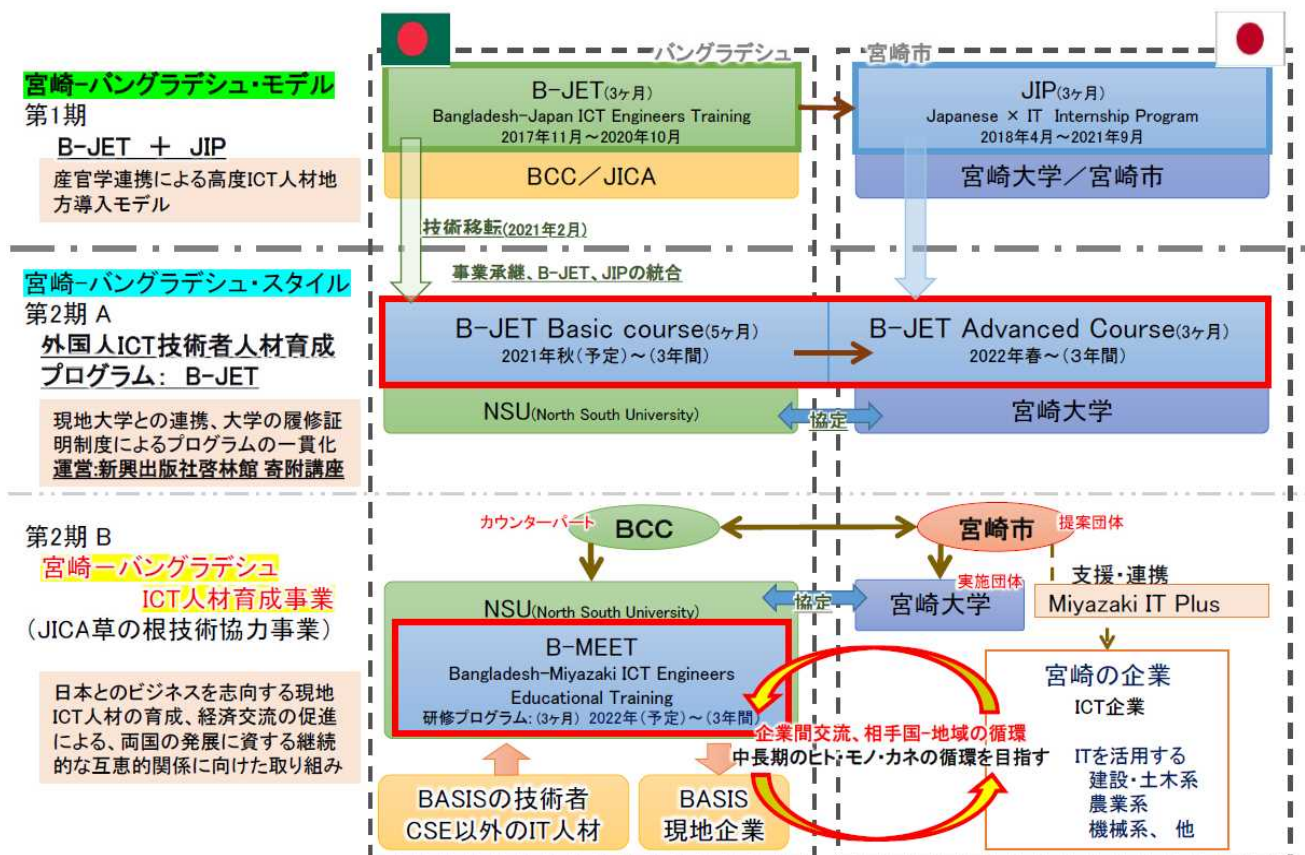
## Miyazaki-Bangladesh Style (July 2021 - present)

In February 2021, North South University (NSU) in Bangladesh and the University of Miyazaki (UoM), in collaboration with Shinko SHINKOSHUPPANSHA KEIRINKAN CO., LTD., BJIT Ltd. (BJIT Group), and B&M Inc., took over B-JET from the Bangladeshi government agencies and JICA with the support of Miyazaki City. In this new B-JET (Phase 2A), the Basic course which expanded local education to 5 months, and the Advanced course which is a short-term study abroad program in Miyazaki, are established as recurrent education through a new certificate program at UoM. This project is also managed by the "Human Resource Development for Foreign ICT Engineers on B-JET Program", a SHINKOSHUPPANSHA KEIRINKAN CO., LTD. endowed lecture.

From now on, the project will be promoted through industry-government-academia cooperation, aiming not only for the introduction of high-level human resources, but also for their establishment in the region, and for a manner and style that is unique to Miyazaki in multicultural coexistence.

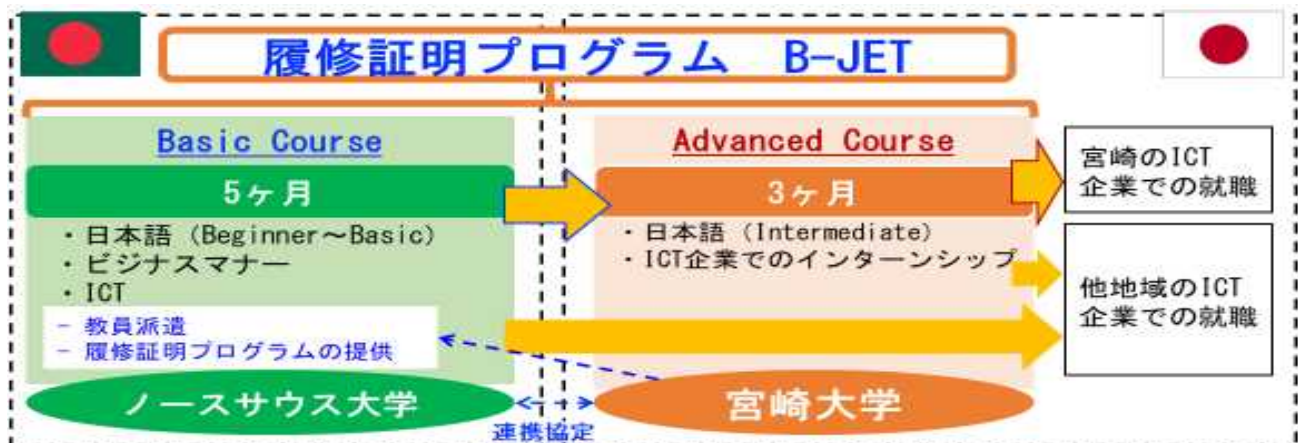
