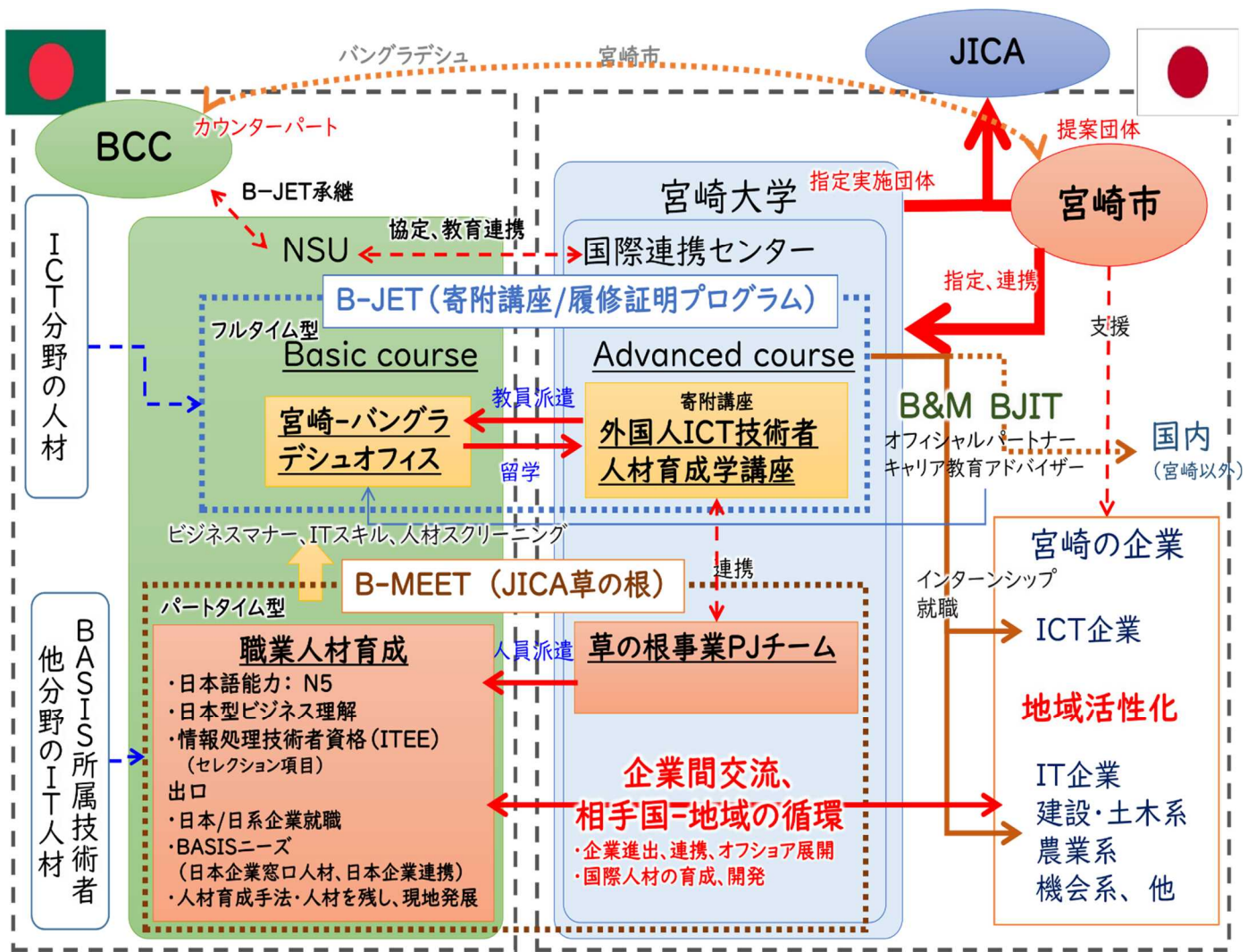
■ Miyazaki City
