Admission Policy

The Department of Veterinary Sciences aims to foster veterinarians with the followings: basic knowledge of agriculture; expertise and ethical perspective of veterinary sciences; skills to apply, practice and develop veterinary knowledge; contributions to regional and international societies.

- (1) The department willing to accept:
 - 1. Those who have wide range of basic knowledge in science, mathematics and language proficiency as basis for studying veterinary sciences.
 - 2. Those who demonstrate interests in wide range of natural sciences.
 - 3. Those who devote to acquire specialized knowledge to improve welfare and well-being of humans and animals.
- (2) Basic selection policy
- 1) General Entrance Examination (First selection Second selection)

The assessment is based on the integrative evaluation of achievements from two criteria: the Center Test and the Independent Achievement Exam. Students are to be evaluated for their academic knowledge and comprehension in basic studies and subjects in sciences up to the high school level and for their abilities to do advanced studies at the university level.

2) Entrance Examination for Returnees

The assessment is based on interview and essay writing. Students are to be evaluated for their interests in the academic discipline in additional to their academic knowledge, comprehension, and independence.

3) Private-funded International Students

The assessment is based on interview and essay writing. Students are to be evaluated for their interest in the academic discipline in additional to their academic knowledge, comprehension, and independence.

(3) Requirement before admitting

The department requires students to possess the followings before admitting to the university: basic academic knowledge in sciences, mathematics, and English that are acquired in high school; and interpersonal skills of independence as well as cooperative personality that can enhance study and enrich university life.
